3. We will hold at least four meetings per year, and send a representative to ASRT quarterly meetings. One of our local annual meetings will be open to the public and will showcase a waterway to promote awareness of our local waterways (chapters are encouraged to invite and involve local government representatives at all levels).
4. Our chapter members will maintain a membership in the ASRT. Their membership must be made in the normal way, online at www.alabamascenicrivertrail.com/members or via widely available paper application forms.
5. A chapter's association with ASRT will allow the use of the custom chapter version of our logo when it appears with the full chapter name. This is the only ASRT identification authorized for use by chapters.
6. Our chapter will provide progress and activity reports to be made available three weeks in advance of the ASRT Annual Meeting held each February.
7. Chapters will elect a president, vice president and secretary/treasurer (or secretary and treasurer) and have and maintain three members at a minimum to fill these offices.
8. Our membership data is allowed only for ASRT and Chapter business and communication. The membership data cannot be sold, given away or used other than for direct communication with chapter members and by the ASRT.
9. ASRT chapters and their members will not develop, engage in, endorse or sponsor programs, services, products or other activities that may be confused with, detract from or damage the products, programs, services, endorsements and other activities that ASRT may develop. This includes disparagement of the Alabama Scenic River Trail, its works, personnel or its logo(s) and trademarks.
10. We will operate in good faith and in accordance with the ethics, safety and community standards of the ASRT. We will uphold the mission of the ASRT. Nothing in our activities will be contrary to the mission of the Alabama Scenic River Trail.
11. While we understand that we are encouraged to develop our own website and social media programs, we also understand that no such media will be allowed to operate unmoderated or unsupervised by the chapter that owns them.
